Throughout our week of Vacation Bible School, the children brought offerings toward Everybody Ought to Know's ministry in India. 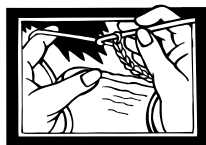

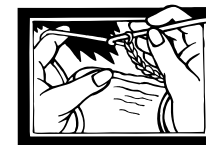
