##### **Matthew 5:38-42 (NIV)**

*<sup>38</sup> "You have heard that it was said, 'Eye for eye, and tooth for tooth.'<sup>[a]</sup>*

*<sup>39</sup> But I tell you, do not resist an evil person. If anyone slaps you on the right cheek, turn to them the other cheek also.*

*<sup>40</sup> And if anyone wants to sue you and take your shirt, hand over your coat as well.*

*<sup>41</sup> If anyone forces you to go one mile, go with them two miles.*

*<sup>42</sup> Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you.*

##### **Matthew 5:38-42 (The Message)**

*<sup>38-42</sup> "Here's another old saying that deserves a second look: 'Eye for eye, tooth for tooth.' Is that going to get us anywhere? Here's what I propose: 'Don't hit back at all.' If someone strikes you, stand there and take it. If someone drags you into court and sues for the shirt off your back, giftwrap your best coat*

*and make a present of it. And if someone takes unfair advantage of you, use the occasion to practice the servant life. No more tit-for-tat stuff. Live generously.*

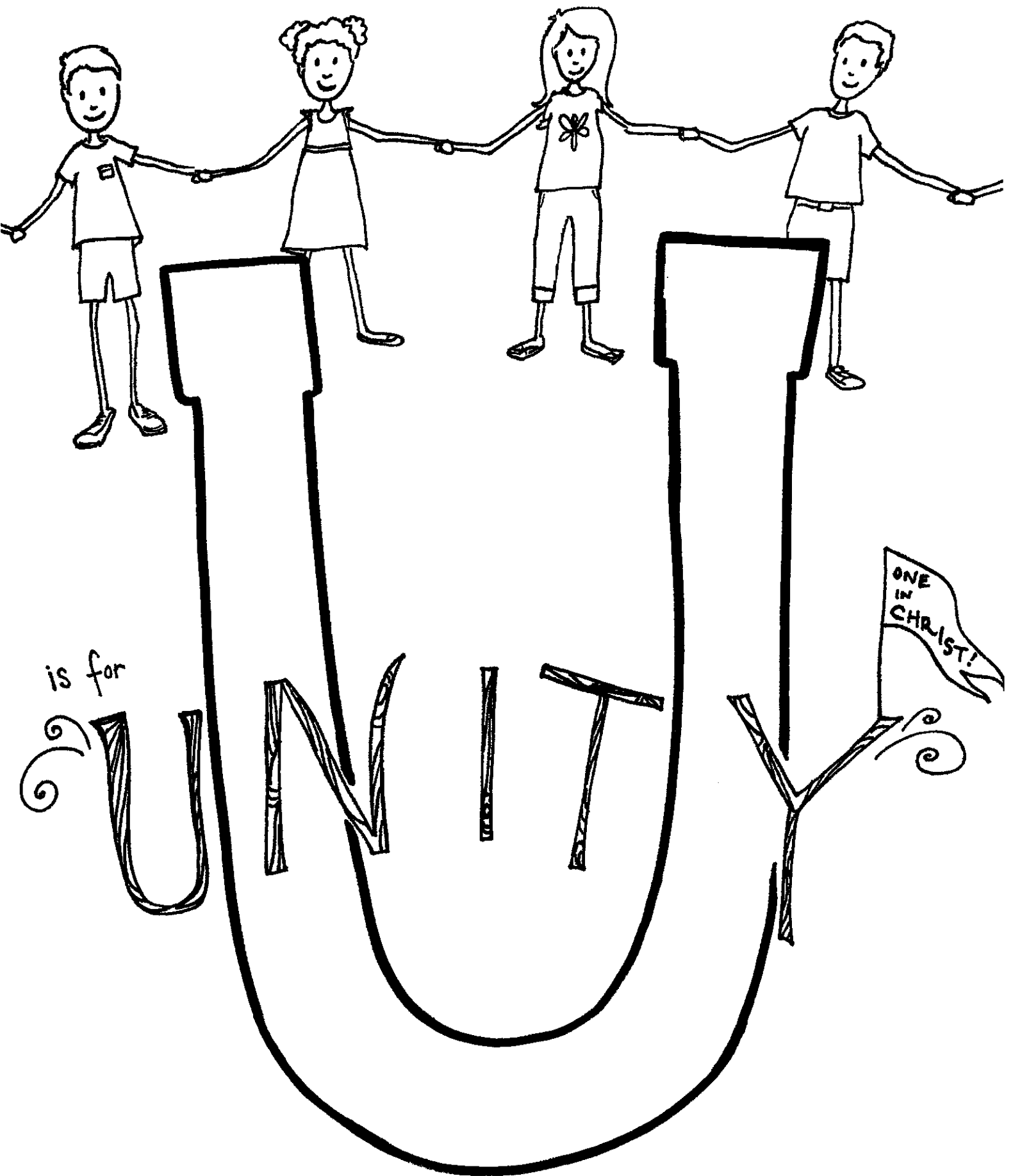
